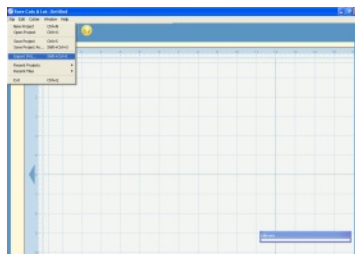
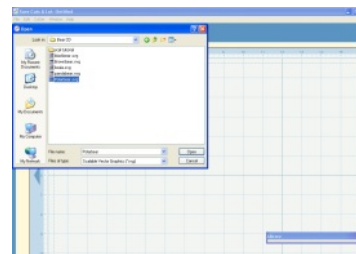


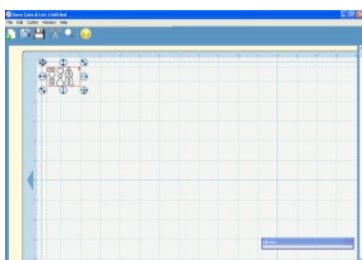
1. Open your Sure Cuts A Lot program



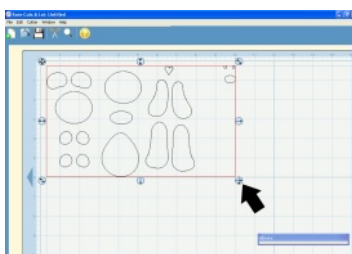
2. Click File, Import SVG



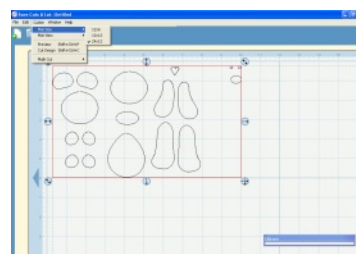
3. Locate the file you wish to import. Select and double click.



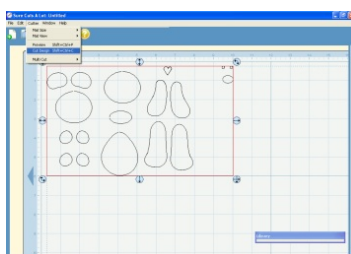
4. Now you should be able to see your file in the Sure Cuts A Lot program.



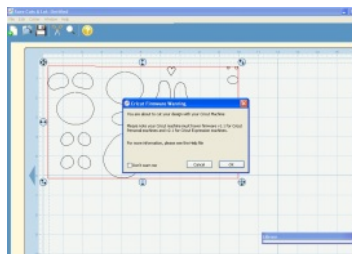
5. Select the bottom right corner of the selection box and resize to desired size. The upper left corner will allow you to move the pattern around so you can reposition it on your mat.

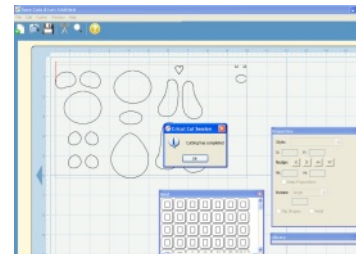
6. Select Cutter, Mat Size and select the mat size you wish to use.



7. Use the SCAL mat on the screen as a guide to position your cardstock on the Cricut cutting mat.



8. Select Cutter, Cut Design. A screen will pop up advising that you are about to cut a design with your Cricut, select OK.



9. Once your pieces are cut, remove them from the mat. You can save your current project as a new ".scut" file so it will be sized and ready the next time you open it.
